The House of Representatives continues to pull their budget together. The Appropriation Committee Chairs are receiving reports from the budget subcommittees, which is the first step in finalizing their budget. The House is scheduled to have their budget completed by the second week in August.

House Appropriation Chairs and House Leadership are well aware of retirees' needs and are working to have funding for retirees in their budget.

Next week the General Assembly will effectively be in recess as the leadership from the House and Senate head to a national legislative meeting.
