Senate Budget to be Unveiled Next Week

The Senate will make public its version of [H 966 - 2019 Appropriations Act](#) next week. The Subcommittees will hold hearings on the Senate's bill on Tuesday and the bill will be heard in the full Appropriations Committee on Wednesday. The Senate, as a body, will consider H 966 on Thursday and Friday. The Senate budget will then be sent back to the House.

Because the Senate's budget development has been closely held, we are not sure what is in store for retirees. We do know the Senate has heard from retirees and we have been advocating on your behalf at the General Assembly, and in the news media.

After the Senate passes its budget next week then the House and Senate will come together to work out their differences in conference.

House and Senate Bills

Most of the bills we are tracking currently rest in the House Rules Committee putting all substantive legislation on hold.
