Legislative Update #19-25 August 16, 2019

Another week and no sign of budget differences being resolved or even negotiated. Both the House and the Senate had short weeks. This week the Senate did not have any committee meetings and only two committee meetings were scheduled in the House. There was little action in legislative general sessions with the House and Senate taking floor votes on only two bills in each chamber. It has been reported the cost for the legislative session since July 1st is more than \$1 million.

Budget Stalemate Continues

With summer winding down there is no break in the partisan bantering on why the State does not have a budget. [H 966 -2019 Appropriations](#) remains in limbo.
